- Civil Engineering – Gr 12 Certificate with a pass/fail in Maths or a pass in Maths Literacy.
- Gr 9 certificate with 2 years relevant industrial experience – full/part time students – fees must be paid by company

2.1 LEVEL 2:

- Compulsory Placement test
- Failed Gr 12
- Passed Gr 11 with a pass/fail in Maths (Engineering) or Maths Literacy (Business Studies)
- Passed Gr 10 with a pass in Maths (Engineering) or Maths Literacy (Business Studies).
- Passed Gr 9 with a pass in Maths will be placed on a waiting list.

2.2 LEVEL 3

- Passed Level 2 (At least 5 subjects – must enrol for supplementary)
- Students can only enrol for 7 subjects in a year

2.3 LEVEL 4

- Passed Level 2 all 7 subjects
- Passed L3 (At least 5 subjects – must enrol for supplementary)
- Students can only enrol for 7 subjects in a year

3. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-SOUTH AFRICANS

The following documents must be produced before the students can register

- Study permit
- Evaluation report from SAQA on qualifications
- Passport / SA ID
